## GENERAL INFORMATION

The Township runs a modified fixed route bus service. This means that the driver will deviate from the fixed route when asked (for up to ¼ of a mile from the fixed route). This deviation is at the discretion of the Office of Transportation. (See Route Deviation) Transit operates two different routes within the Township, one five days a week and one on Wednesdays only.

All vehicles follow NJ Department of Transportation regulations and are handicapped accessible. All service animals, such as Seeing Eye Dogs, are always welcome. This service is paid through a grant from NJ Transit, the Township and the FTA.

## FARES

There is a fare of one dollar each way. There are a variety of fare policies for riders to choose from. A half-fare policy is available for senior and disabled passengers, and frequent rider passes are available for all riders. Passes may be purchased from the driver.

## HOURS OF OPERATION

Service for the main route which includes Upper Greenwood Lake will be on Monday to Friday from 9:00 am to 4:30 pm. Oak Ridge/ Newfoundland service hours are Wednesdays ONLY from 9:00 am to 2:00 pm.

## PASSENGER CONDUCT

A passenger may be suspended or refused service for an indefinite period of time due to disorderly conduct. Such action can be taken for the following reasons: eating or drinking while on the vehicle, smoking, using foul language, not using seat belts or any action the driver and the coordinator may deem to be a safety hazard.

It is the responsibility of the Township of West Milford Office of Transportation to provide transportation, without discrimination, to all Senior and Disabled residents.

## ELIGIBILITY

- Senior Citizens: A senior citizen who has reached the age of 60 and will submit proof of age is eligible for transportation service.
- Disabled: An individual who has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more "Major Life Activities", including such things as (but not limited to) caring for oneself, walking, seeing, hearing, or speaking.
- Temporary Disability: Any individual with a disability who is unable to navigate a fixed route bus service or operate a motor vehicle for a period of 12 months or less, and who has a medical statement verifying the length of time, will be considered temporarily disabled.

## APPOINTMENTS:

We do not transport to New York State except for the town of Warwick, NY. We do transport within Passaic County and five (5) miles into the surrounding counties, including Bergen and Essex.

## CANCELLATION AND NO SHOW POLICY:

The following will be grounds for suspension of service:

- Failure to call to cancel service.
- Canceling less than 24 hours prior to scheduled pick-up. All appointments must be cancelled no later than 24 hours prior to pickup (calls must be made during business hours 8:30 am to 4:30 pm, Monday –Friday) Appointments that are not cancelled within the required 24 hours period will be considered a no show.
- Not at designated location at time of pick-up.

In cases where an individual consistently misses scheduled appointments (no show), transit service can be suspended for a reasonable period of time.

## SUGGESTED DONATION

All van service has a suggested donation of \$1.00 round trip. You will not be refused service for not making a donation.
